CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The Scientific Program Committee invites submission of abstracts in the fields of biology, behavioral and social sciences, epidemiology, clinical practice and health, and social research, planning and practice for oral or poster presentations. These abstracts should be original and not be published elsewhere at the time of submission.

When submitting abstract, it should be indicated clearly whether or not the paper should be considered for oral presentations. From the submitted abstracts, the Scientific Program Committee will select oral presentations that will then be assigned to different sessions.

Each speaker will be given 10 minutes for presentation and answering questions. Submissions not selected for oral presentation will be assigned to the poster presentation. Instructions for preparation of the abstract and the template for the abstract can be downloaded at the congress web site, where the subject/field codes for the abstract can also be found.

The presenting authors of the accepted abstracts are required to register and pay the appropriate registration fee before July 31, 2007. Late registration may result in exclusion from the Scientific Program and the Abstract Book.
